Damiansville District #62 has an Integrated Pest Management (IPM) Policy, which incorporates building maintenance, sanitation, physical barriers, and as a last resort, the safest, most effective means of pesticide. In our school physical

plant, we have found it necessary to conduct a pesticide spraying on a monthly basis. This occurs after school on the second Friday of each month.

We are creating a voluntary registry, whereby families will receive a special notification two days prior to any airborne pesticide application. If any family wishes to be on this list, please notify the office and we will include them on our registry.
