Meeting Called to order

Treasurer's report read by Whitey and approved
Lori gave update on money raised through Scrip Program.

Superintendent's Report – Mr. Toebe thanked the PTO for the money donated last year towards technology. Stated his goal is to purchase Promethian boards for each classroom.

Old Business

Double D Auction on May 16th – all funds donated to Crystal Fuehne. Approx. \$560. Thank you to everyone who donated time, baked goods, drinks, etc.

Fundraisers for 2009-2010 school year/allocation of money – Mr. Toebe suggested additional books would need to be purchased for the library. Estimated we would need to spend about \$5000-\$6000 on books per year to stay updated. All money will go into a general fund at this time. Allocation of money to be determined as needed.

Mulch for Playground – has been purchased and applied. Inspection of playground reveals we are within/exceed safety requirements

Bylaws – committee to convene and provide input on update to PTO Charter Bylaws.

New Business

Scrip Program – Encourage more families to participate. Will offer incentive for ordering next month.

Quarter Auction – Date set for Nov. 20. Nancy is continuing to book vendors at this time. Asked if anyone knew a direct sale consultant to forward their information to Nancy.

Chicken and Beer Dance – Angie is looking into dates and should have one by the next meeting.

Trick-or-Treat Night in D-ville – October 25th. PTO to purchase small item to disperse to Trick-or-Treaters.

Open forum

Mr Toebe discussed spending \$1000 per year for educational/fun assemblies for out students. Voted and agreed to grant the school \$1000.

Lori asked if the school continued to participate in Campbell's labels promotion. Mr. Toebe reported we participate in Nestle Waters, Campbell's labels, Box Tops for Education, and printer ink cartridges. These programs are not run through the PTO. Suggested looking into Capri Sun's program
